You can still see traces of Roman influence, such as a late medieval atonement cross along the way in [Bobingen](#) and the thousand-year-old Benedictine Abbey in Thierhaupten.

Other impressive sights to observe are the landmark *Hexentürmchen* (Witches' Turrets) in [Schwabmünchen](#), the baroque Holy Cross Pilgrimage Church in Biberbach, and majestic Hammel Castle in [Neusäß](#).

For more modern attractions, you will want to pay a visit to the inspiring Balloon Museum in [Gersthofen](#) or the fascinating Mask Museum in the market town of [Diedorf](#). Or how about taking a break at the huge King Spa bathing facility at [Königsbrunn](#), with its indoor and outdoor pools.

Although the Augsburg District is the third most populous district in [Bavaria](#), it also includes one of its most sparsely populated areas, the Western Forests. This enchanting 1,200-square-kilometer preserve offers you a wonderful escape to nature — with vibrant, forested hills and picturesque hamlets in the south and extensive woodlands and cycling trails in the north.
