Snow skiing, hiking and cycling are just a few of the ways you can bide your time here. Flowers, fruits and herbs grow in natural profusion, which you can purchase fresh at the local markets.

The town of [Bad Tölz](#) is especially noted for its medieval Stadtpfarr Church, the iodine-laden spa waters at the *Kurverwaltung*, and providing simply stunning views of the Alps.

Meanwhile, [Wolfratshausen](#), which is nestled in the charmingly unspoiled countryside between the Loisach and Isar rivers, is best thought of for its great rafting courses, as well as water sports opportunities at Lake Starnberg to the west.

In [Geretsried](#), the largest town in the district, you can enjoy your fill of local culture. It is a popular venue for its many festivals and more than 90 recurring cultural events.

Performing arts and concerts are also regular offerings in the alpine villages of Benediktbeuern, with its famous old Benedictine abbey, and [Lenggries](#), which depends largely on a steady stream of hiking tourists for its economy.
