[Pfungstadt](#) goes one better by accompanying its festival with fireworks serving its internationally known beer — the *Pfungstädter*.

[Weiterstadt](#), on the other hand, offers an open air film festival each year. The woods and other wild areas around the town are also deserving of a mention as they are both picturesque and benefit from camping areas and communal barbecue areas!
