There are plenty of historic sites that will soon make you forget the modern developments and lifestyles that can be quite swamping.

Bonlanden is one such in the town center area where you'll find medieval homes and a fortress within an enclosure. This stone structure dates back to the 14th century and can only be peeked at from the outside. It is now a parsonage.
