

Freizeit-Land Geiselwind -- Wild Birds And Roller Coasters

Freizeit-Land Geiselwind had its beginnings in 1969 when Buyer Mensinger began collecting birds and needed a place to show them off. So the park was opened as a way to showcase his beautiful animals and has since grown into a modern amusement park.

Main Themes

4D, Wild Animals, Roller Coasters, Water Rides, Ferris Wheel, Carousel, Boat Rides

Operating Times

Freizeit-Land is open from April to October. Hours are usually 9 am to 6 pm, but the park closes at 5 pm in the off-season.

Location

Located in its namegiver, the small municipality of Geiselwind, Freizeit-Land lies conveniently at the Autobahn A3 — between [Nuremberg](#) and [Würzburg](#) (less than an hour away, respectively).

[Stuttgart](#) can be reached in 2 hours at 187 km (116 mi).

How To Get To The Freizeit-Land Geiselwind

By Air

The closest airport is at [Nuremberg](#), which is about an hour away by car. You can transfer from the airport to a train as well.

[Frankfurt Airport](#) is another option as it's only 1.5 hours away by car.

By Car

From Nuremberg, take the A3 to Würzburg and go off at exit 76 (Geiselwind), and then turn right and at the next big corner to the left (Schlüsselfelder Straße), which leads through the village right to the park. Or simply follow the signs since it's well sign-posted at and after the exit.

From Stuttgart, the A81 will take you to the A3 towards Nuremberg (via Würzburg). You go off at exit 76 (Geiselwind) and, as above, turn right and follow the signs to the park.

By Public Transport

Unfortunately, there is no direct rail connection to Freizeit-Land Geiselwind. However, you can connect to this amusement park via railroad and bus.

From both Nuremberg or Würzburg, get off at [Kitzingen](#). There is a bus (No. 8150) that connects the station to Wiesentheid (Landschulheim), where you can catch a second bus (No. 8111) to Freizeit-Land Geiselwind. This journey takes 2 – 3 hours, though, so plan accordingly!

Freizeit-Land Geiselwind Highlights

T-Rex Tower

The T-Rex Tower lets its riders experience a free fall and G-force effects as they plummet through the air.

Boomerang Roller Coaster

This fun thrill ride carries its passengers at high speeds of up to 75km/h (47 mph) going forwards and backwards at heights of 38 m (125 ft). The corkscrew track loops and curves for a heart-racing, adrenaline-pumping good time. ;-)

Wild Water Train

This classic log flume takes you through an old sawmill and other historical reproductions. And then finally, you take the plunge as the river track dives and splashes all around you.

More Freizeit-Land Geiselwind Attractions

For old carnival lovers, Freizeit-Land conjures up nostalgic old rides like the ferris wheel, carousel, swan boat ride and paddle boats. Go back even further in time at Dinosaur county where you can sit at the feet of a giant T-Rex monster.

The Viking boat ride will swing you side to side while the Enterprise centrifuge ride will lift you through the air.

There is also a wide array of animals on showcase here, which is why the park was originally founded. The bird safari is a testament to the park's beginnings with Mr. Mensinger's bird collection. Visit apes, flamingos, storks and owls when you are tired of the amusement park rides.

Restaurants

Diners have a choice of several restaurants. There is traditional German food like sausage, sauerbraten and schnitzel at the Bavarian beer garden or Tropica restaurant.

But you can also have pizza or pasta at the Pizzeria Bella Italia.

Prices

Freizeit-Land's prices are unique in that they're not based on age, but height! So if you're a cute small person you've got an advantage here. :-)
