Head to [Neustadt an der Donau](#) for a relaxing spa experience in the thermal waters of Bad Gögging, with its indoor and outdoor pools, massage services and unique aqua-cycling training. Or go to Riedenburg, cozily nestled on a river between two hills in the Nature Park, where you can experience the thrills and speed of a summer bobsled run.

Then, visit the town of [Abensberg](#) to see the monolithic white-washed *Herzogskasten* Town Museum and to sample beer freshly brewed from hops grown locally. And speaking of hops, the town of Mainberg has a museum dedicated entirely to how this important grain is grown and used.

The district capital is the town of [Kelheim](#), home of the area's most easily recognized landmark, the 19th-century *Befreiungshalle* at the top of Mount Michelsberg. This monument marks the region's struggle for freedom and victories over Napoleon in 1813–15 — a must-see on your itinerary.
