

## Nuremberg Airport (NUE) -- A Major Hub For Air Berlin

Nuremberg Airport (NUE), also called Airport Nürnberg, is [Bavaria](#)'s second busiest airport (after [Munich Airport](#)), Germany's tenth largest, and hub to the country's second biggest airline, Air Berlin. It has one terminal with two departure halls and one hall for arrivals.

### Distance

7 km (5 mi) north of the [Nuremberg](#) city center.

### Hours Of Operation

Nuremberg operates 24 hours a day, every day.

### Getting To And From Nuremberg International Airport

Nuremberg airport is well-served and easily accessed by public transportation. Its close proximity to the city center means you could even ride a bicycle from the center to the airport. ;-)

### Long-Distance Trains

There is no direct connection to long-distance trains. But the U-bahn (U2 line) will get you to the main station in just twelve minutes.

### Regional Trains

The U-bahn subway is a convenient way to get to and from the airport. The U2 metro will take you from central Nuremberg to the airport in about twelve minutes.

Remember to buy and validate your ticket BEFORE you get on board.

## **Buses**

There are two city buses that run to and from Nuremberg and the airport every ten minutes. Bus number 32 and 33 stop just in front of the departures hall in Terminal 1.

## **Shopping**

Nuremberg Airport has shopping for all your immediate needs. The airport shop allows you to pick up cigarettes or souvenirs. The travel shop sells medicine, sunglasses, sweets and Hummel figurines. And of course, there is also duty-free shopping at this international airport.

## **Food & Drink**

A snack bar and bistro will help you to fill up before getting on your flight, with their offers of sandwiches and chocolates. If you're in the mood for a romantic dinner, be sure to head to the Mövenpick Restaurant, which provides brunch or Mediterranean buffet. :-)

## **Fun Facts**

If you have some time to kill and are tired of being stuck indoors, make your way to Nuremberg's Observation Deck. Admission is free and you can watch from a close but safe distance as the planes lift off and touch down.
