More wonders await you at the Stiftskirche Ramelsloh on Piazza del Duomo, the St. Ansgar Church on Bahnhofstraße, and the Church of St. Altfried Meckel Field. They are all wonderful repositories of medieval art and cultural treasures.

Seevetal has a number of museums to give you a varied taste of its culture and art. The German Salt Museum is a monument to the Saline Luneburg. For an authentic rendition of the town's cultural history the Kiekeberg Open Air Museum is the place to go. In addition to these are the Bossard Art Facility, the Museum in Marstall, the Viking Museum in Haithabu, and the Rail Museum in Hittfeld.

Being endowed with more than its natural share of scenic landscapes, Seevetal has a wealth of outdoor activities. A number of bicycle tours take you through its historic landmarks, museums and

mills, forests, and mountains.
