

## **Skyline Park -- Plaza Of Sky-High Adrenaline-Filled Thrill Rides**

Skyline Park is located in Germany's popular holiday destination, [Bavaria](#), and its [Unterallgäu district](#). It offers thrilling roller coasters and adrenaline rides, playgrounds and carousels for the kids and 4D cinema and summertime fun for everyone else.

### **Opening Times**

Skyline Park opens in April and closes its doors at the end of October. Typical hours run from 9:30 am to 6:00 pm, with a later closing time of 7 pm in the summer peak season of June, July and August.

### **Main Themes**

Roller Coasters, Extreme Rides, 4D, Water Rides, Wild Animals, Halloween, Ferris Wheel, Boat Rides, Carousels

### **Skyline Park Highlights**

#### **Sky Wheel**

The Sky Wheel is a thrill ride that begins with a vertical climb of 46 m (150 ft), where it then does a backwards loop, but not at a breakneck speed. This ride makes a slow upside-down loop, letting its passengers scream in delight — or terror — as they are hanging upside down at 1G forces!

#### **Sky Circle**

A giant needle circles around as seats are connected to each side. As the needle spins faster, the chairs flip upside down at dizzying speeds. That's the Sky Circle — a must for adrenaline lovers.

#### **Sky Shot**

If the previous rides don't get your adrenaline pumping enough, though, then the Sky Shot is sure to do just that. As you are suspended in a small circular seat attached to a bungee cord, you will literally fly through the air as your chair bounces up and down between two towers!

### **More Skyline Park Attractions**

If thrill rides aren't your thing, Skyline Park offers plenty of alternatives. There are bumper cars,

carousels, boat rides, and a 4D cinema for those who'd rather keep their feet on the ground.

They also hold an annual Halloween festival, so be sure to bring a costume if you visit in the late autumn season.

## Restaurants

Visitors to Skyline Park are sure to leave satiated. There are crepe stands, beer gardens and the Löwi's restaurant for a nice meal. Food choices include traditional German schnitzel, currywurst, chicken wings, chicken nuggets and potatoes.

## Location

Skyline Park is in the middle of the triangle [Munich](#) — [Ulm](#) — [Lake Constance](#), near [Bad Wörishofen](#), and all three ends are more or less an hour-long car journey away.

## How To Get To The Skyline Park

### By Air

The [Munich Airport](#) is the closest major German airport to the Skyline Park in Bad Wörishofen. For the rest of the journey, see below...

### By Public Transport

Despite its official location in Bad Wörishofen, the actual train stop for the Skyline Park is Rammingen (Bayern). From there it's only a 800 m footpath (instead of 1,500 m otherwise)!

The two-hour ride from Munich is with limited direct trains. So you may need to change trains at Mindelheim or Buchloe.

### By Car

From the Autobahn A96 (from either direction), get off at the exit Bad Wörishofen and follow the signs to the park (~1500 m).

You navigation system users, enter *Bad Wörishofen* for the city and *Im Hartfeld* for the street.
