Particularly recommended is Wutach Gorge which is known locally for its richness of plant and animal life.

Also in nearby [Bonndorf](#), well known for its annual carnival, the castle gardens are presented in a relaxing Japanese style — perfect for whiling away a quiet afternoon.

Fans of the outdoors may also be interested to note the outdoor opera each summer in [Bad Säckingen](#) park and the iris garden at [Wehr](#).

Prepare to be astounded at the cathedral at St. Blasien. It is **one of the largest domed buildings in Europe** stretching across an expanse of 36 meters (or 39 yards).

But it is not just the size that is notable. It is a beautiful building in its own right. The interior almost glows as the light bounces off the white columns and walls.

Lastly, remember to look up for the ceiling fresco.
